PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO D.PHARM COURSE IN CHRISTIAN MINORITY INSTITUTIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026

1. INTRODUCTION

This prospectus relates to admission to D. Pharm course in Caritas College of Pharmacy, Kottayam and St. Joseph's College of Pharmacy, Cherthala.

The Name, Address, Code of Colleges and their intake are given below.

This prospectus contains rules and conditions of Admission to D. Pharm course for the Academic year 2025-2026 in the above said institutions.

This prospectus is subject to modification /deletion as may be deemed necessary by the said institutions, Pharmacy Council of India, and also subject to further orders if any passed by courts of law.

Each College has its own policies of reservations which are separately explained in the respective pages (Annexure –I&II) relating to each college

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

NATIONALITY:

Candidates must be citizens of India/Children or dependents of Non-Resident Indians.

ACADEMIC:

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics/Computer-science are eligible.

Or

An equivalent examination approved by the Pharmacy Council of India for admission to D.Pharm.

Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination.

AGE:

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age. Upper age limit will be as per the directions from the Pharmacy Council of India.

3. HOW TO APPLY

- a. The common prospectus along with application form can be obtained directly from any of the above said two college offices on payment of Rs.500/-
or
- b. By sending a request along with a D.D. for Rs.550/- drawn in favor of the Director/Principal of any of the member college.
or
- c. Application forms can also be obtained from following branches of South Indian Bank (SIB) by payment of Rs.500/-
SIB Branches:
 - i. South Indian Bank, Thellakom – Kottayam, Near Caritas Hospital
 - ii. South Indian Bank, Cherthala – Near Manorama Junctionor
- d. It can be downloaded from the respective college websites.

Application fee can be paid online and duly filled applications should be send to the respective colleges along with the application fee receipt.

THE APPLICATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED AS DETAILED BELOW.

- a) One single application is sufficient for all colleges.
- b) The candidate should indicate the order of preference of the college for admission in the specific format provided in the application form.
- c) Completed applications should be submitted to the respective college of first choice either by Registered post or by hand. Applicants shall obtain acknowledgement from the respective college office, if the application is submitted in person.
- d) Candidate who wish to apply to Reserved seats in Community Quota may do so on the basis of the reservation policy of each college as provided in the Annexures I & II of the respective colleges, by marking in the space provided in the application form (copies of relevant documents to prove eligibility to reservation as mentioned in the prospectus have to be attached).
- e) Applications submitted should be complete in all aspects. The candidate should fill all the items in the application form in his/her own handwriting.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FORM:

1. Copy of the SSLC Certificate (Self attested) to prove date of birth.
2. Copy of plus two/XII /VHSE Mark Cards (Self attested).
3. Copy of Character and Conduct Certificate (Self attested).
4. In cases where the candidate claims any sort of reservation/preference, provided for each college - Documents to prove such claims as described in Annexure– I/II by each college.
5. A medical fitness certificate showing suitability to undergo the course.
(*submit it only at the time of admission)

Note: Candidates are instructed not to enclose any original certificate along with the application.

Applications not accompanied by documents in proof of claims therein, is liable to be summarily rejected without further intimation. Documents / Certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances.

No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or document after the submission of the application. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected.

4. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

Selection will be based on the rank list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Physics and Chemistry in the second year of the qualifying examination. If there is a tie, marks obtained in Chemistry will be considered, if there is still a tie, marks obtained in English will be considered, if there is still a tie, the candidate with higher age on the date of counseling will be considered.

Percentage of seats set apart under various heads. Details of seat allocation under various categories in the respective colleges are mentioned in the Annexure – I / II of this prospectus.

Furnishing false information or particulars would result in the forfeiture of admission to the course. In addition, it will invite the relevant provisions of the criminal law of the land.

After scrutiny of applications, the merit list of the different categories will be published on the notice boards of the member colleges.

Admission will be on the basis of a counseling based on the preferential options of candidates to the seats available in each institution. The venue of counseling will be at individual institutions on a fixed date and time as decided in a common platform.

5. ADMISSION

For genuine reasons, respective managements will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if otherwise eligible.

No marks will be allotted for interview.

Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college concerned after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and Stationery fee, failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled.

6. REFUND OF FEES

If an admitted candidate leaves the college after the closing date of admission, the candidate has to pay liquidated damages to the tune of full fee of the course. TC and other Certificates

will be issued only after clearing all the dues.

8. CODE OF CONDUCT

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution where the candidate has taken admission.

9. CAUTION

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING.

Ragging / any type of misconduct towards any students either in the college campus or outside will be considered as a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their study.

Every student shall at the time of admission furnish a character certificate from the institute where from he/she has passed the qualifying examination/the course last attended. Such a Certificate should mention the status of his/ her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/ she had displayed persistent violent, or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others.
